

Spotting Locations

1. Myrtle Avenue

Most popular spot at Heathrow, but only useful when aircraft are landing on runway 27L. Named after small residential street close to Hatton Cross, with a grass area at the end. Perfect for photographs. Postcode TW14 9QU.

2. Runway 09L Approach

Stanwell Moor Road runs the length of the western perimeter of the airport. Park by the side of the road at your own risk. Aircraft pass low overhead on approach to runway 09L.

3. Runway 27R Approach

A walk along the Eastern Perimeter Road can help you find a good spot to photograph arrivals on 27R. Security patrols regularly monitor this area and ask spotters to stay a few metres from the fence. Can't see any other parts of the airport.

4. Academy/Renaissance Hotel

Car park next to Renaissance has small grandstand and views of all movements on 09L/27. Not good for photographs. Postcode TW6 2AP.

One of the best spotting hotels. Rooms facing the airport on the top three floors overlook the eastern end of the airport and runway 27L. Most movements can be seen regardless of runway direction, and nearer aircraft photographed (albeit through triple-glazed glass).

Public Transport

Free buses run around the perimeter roads and between terminals. You can reach spotting locations 3 and 4 using bus #285 from the central terminal area, or bus #423 from Terminal 5.

Hatton Cross Underground station is near location 1.
